



Basic Obedience Commands

Here: come to you when called

Heel: walk at your left side at your pace & not pulling, on & off leash

Sit: sit down & stay sitting (the word "sit" is used both for sit & stay)

No, Sit: do not jump up, correction that is used for unwanted jumping on a person

Down: lie down and continue to stay down

Drop: to release, having dog to let go of whatever is in its mouth.

Wait: sit and wait, during food prep or opening a door

Kennel: get into dog run, dog crate, or load up into a vehicle/ATV

Out: go outside for playtime or to potty

Quiet: command used for a dog to be silent in the crate, kennel, or indoors.

We also address any behavior issues that you are having at home such as excessive barking & overall manners.
